

## **SuperTech Seeds & Your Application**

By submitting your application ("Application") to the SuperTech Seeds CRF No\_Code Pre-Accelerator Programme, you confirm and acknowledge the following:

1. You are over 18.
2. You have a portfolio of work and some work experience.
3. You understand that SuperTech is the market-facing cluster organisation and the accountable body is Greater Birmingham & Solihull Local Enterprise Partnership (GBSLEP). SuperTech Seeds activity is delivered in partnership with the sub-contractor Million Labs Ltd (11522442) ("Partner").
4. You are located and have rights to work in the UK – and where relevant – within the West Midlands as defined by the West Midlands Combined Authority Area.
5. It is anticipated the majority of the pre-accelerator activity will be conducted virtually although there may be times when physical attendance is required and/ or beneficial. This will always be in the context of wider UK restrictions arising from the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic.
6. The facts contained in your Application, portfolio of work and any other documentation you submit as part of the Application (together "Application Materials") are true and complete to the best of your knowledge. You understand that any false information or significant omissions may disqualify you from the application process.
7. The Application Materials are your own original work and to the extent that they include the work of any third-parties, you have all necessary consents, permissions and releases to use such work. To the best of your knowledge the Application Materials do not: (a) violate any right of privacy or publicity of any person, whether contractual, statutory, common law or otherwise and/or (b) infringe any intellectual property rights of any third party.
8. You agree to immediately notify SuperTech team if you are convicted of any crime while your Application is pending or during any period of the pre-accelerator activities, if successful.
9. Acceptance onto the programme is at the sole discretion of GBSLEP.
10. On acceptance of an offer from SuperTech Seeds to participate, you authorise the Partners to investigate of all statements contained in your Application (and accompanying Application Materials or cv/resume, if any) and further authorise any person, school, current employer (except as expressly noted), past employers(s), whether or not named in your Application (and accompanying Application Materials or accompanying cv/resume, if any), to provide Partners with records, information and opinion that may be useful in making a decision to offer you a place on the SuperTech Seeds pre-accelerator.
